

Description of Project

Book in a Box is a chance to bring your book to life by putting together objects that relate to your book and using them to tell the story of what your book is all about.

Directions

- Obtain a cardboard box with a lid or flaps that close.
- Choose at least 5 objects to put inside your box that represent significant events, characters, objects, or themes from your book. It is best to try to obtain the actual object, but some objects are too big to fit in a box. In this case, you may use a model of the object.
- For each object, write a paragraph (at least 5 sentences) explaining what it is and its importance/connection to your book.
- Decorate the outside of the box. Treat it as the “cover” of your book box. Include the title, author, and your name.
